Individual accomplishments

- Developed personalised external facing Domino web portal, enabling huge infrastructure/SSL cost savings as many different clients were able to use the same site.
- Developed both advanced web applications and client applications for Domino 5 & 6
- Coded integration tools for exchange of data between notes and backend databases (SQL/ODBC), e.g. HP simcon
- Development tasks often exceed 14 hours day, and shifts during projects and when clients required reached 36+ hours in a straight shift
- Trained mainframe application developers in Lotus Notes and Web based technologies
- Rewriting of Existing bank application to run on the Notes/Domino systems (both thin and thick client)
- Creation/integration and maintenance of world biggest implementation of Lotus's Domino Workflow integrated with Domino.Doc
- Coding of custom Administration tools for the Infrastructure team to deal with the bank's unique situation.
- Provided a friendly and easy to talk to link for users to explain their requirements/issues to (inc. 1st to 3rd line support)..
- Able to gauge the required levels of risk in the constant balancing act between security and functionality, where they relate to both web and thick client application
- Used by 6 VP's within the Bank as a technical research tool and in-house consultant into such platforms as Microsoft .Net, J2EE and WEB Security and often provided senior managers with Business analysis as to the best technical solution for a problem. As a consequence of many such reports I was given the task of taking the project to the next step and produce business cases for the project, and in a number of cases I took the project all the way to completion.

- Wrote and implemented software for over 50 servers (many client/internet facing), with a huge variety of configurations.
- Constant exposure and adapting to new technologies based on promises made to clients by the business.
- Migrating 3000 users from MS exchange 5.5/2000/2003 and mainframe mail to Lotus Notes 4.5. – 6.5 as well as constant migrations to and from various mail systems as the Bank actively acquires and sells business.
- Provide the Bank with Global Development standards.
- Constructed Reverse proxy infrastructure for multiple n-layer web service projects

Successfully completed a Domino based global legal release and authorization system for both browser and thick client, which had to deal with extremely strict hardware limitations as well as having a colorful GUI interface, and would never develop replication/save conflicts despite users on 350 servers potentially editing/authorising the same document at the same time. In addition created a MS Access/SQL based search and report system that would access the Notes databases via ODBC.

Part of GE GCF (UK)'s Critical Technology Group, the group was responsible for providing technical resource to backup the outsourced support contract, developing/implementing new systems and providing technical solutions as well as working closely with change management to provide quality results within SLAs.
